The North-South stretch of the **A9 motorway Berlin-Munich** and
the East-West stretch of the **A4 motorway
Dresden-Eisenach-Frankfurt/Main** intersect at Jena.

There are two motorway exits from the city of Jena
onto the A4 motorway via the junctions
Jena-Zentrum and **Jena-Göschwitz**.

The **A9 motorway Berlin-Nuremberg** can be accessed
via the nearby **Hermsdorfer Kreuz** motorway intersection.

Jena can be reached via **federal road** using the
B 88 Naumburg – Jena – Rudolstadt and the
B 7 Eisenach-Erfurt-Weimar-Jena-Eisenberg.



The nearest **airport** is located in **Erfurt** (ERF), the state capital of Thuringia, 70 km from Jena.
The car journey from the airport to Jena via the A4 is around **45 minutes**.

Leipzig-Halle Airport (LEJ) is a **one-hour** drive away and can be reached via the A9
motorway.
